

The map from which the routes (highlight yellow) on image "1800 routes.jpg" were extracted was ...

**"The Grand Southern Tour of ENGLAND"**

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- The most notable absence on the map is the village of Speen; indeed few of the roads in Speen are shown. Hampden Road, Flowers Bottom, Chapel Hill are not shown as routes at all. Three routes meet at Pye Corner (where the Chapel was being founded around that time); the route from Upper North Dean (now Speen Road), the route from Walter's Ash (now a footpath), and Coleheath Bottom which linked to Parslows Hillock (better known as the Pink and Lilly) via the footpath on the SW edge of Monkton Wood.
- Other places notable by their absence ...
  - Bryant's Bottom (only parts of Bryants Bottom Road were in use)
  - Naphill
  - Lower North Dean
  - Prestwood
  - Only the Saunderton village at Bledlow Road near Horsenden is shown, not "new" village at the rail station (though Saunderton Lee is marked at the bottom of Little Lane as now)
- Other roads notable by their absence ...
  - Not surprisingly there are few connections between the missing village of Speen and Princes Risborough; no Whiteleaf Hill, Brimmer's Road, Kop Hill or Cadsdean Road, so no routes down the scarp from Wardrobes to Ellesborough Church
  - No Hampden Road (the other one!) up the valley from Warrendene to Rignall Road (which also is not shown, though Rignall Farm is shown)
  - Not surprisingly New Road which links the villages of Loosely Row, Lacey Green, and Walters Ash is not shown
- Places named close to Speen/North Dean on the map are ...
  - Walter's Ash
  - Warren (O.S. Lower Warren Farm)
  - Great Kingshill
  - Ham<sup>n</sup> Row, Ham<sup>n</sup> S<sup>t</sup> (O.S. Great Hampden)
  - Whitcliff Cross (O.S. Whiteleaf Hill)
  - Pycott (O.S. Piggots and Pigots)
  - Upper North Dean
  - Pole Cat (now and possibly then the Pub)
  - Gollings Hanger Farm (nr. Prestwood)
  - Hawk Hill (O.S. Monkton and Monkton Farm)
  - Darvels Hill (O.S. Darvillshill)
  - Iron Bench Kiln (O.S. Kiln Lane)
  - Leasy Gr. (O.S. Lacey Green)
  - Red Lane End (O.S. Redland End)
  - Small Dean (O.S. Small Dean Farm)

  - **Gt. Hampden†**
  - **Lit. Hampden†**
  - **Bradenham†**
  - **Hitchendon†** (O.S. Hughenden)
